

Life Network 2016 Annual Report



In 2016, volunteers donated approximately 10,100 hours of time, valued at approximately \$151,000. In addition, 261 hours of professional services valued at \$18,302 were contributed as reflected in our detailed financial statements.



Ministry Statistics

SINCE SEPTEMBER OF 2016 LIFE NETWORK WAS HONORED TO...

 Provide pregnancy tests, options counseling, ultrasounds, education, referrals and emergency material supplies for 8,495 clients.

Performed 486 ultrasounds for those making decisions about their pregnancies; of those, 255 clients were abortion-vulnerable. After seeing their little one on our ultrasound, 89% of those considering abortion

made a decision for life for their babies. We celebrate 203 babies whose moms and dads chose life instead of abortion!

• We rejoice that 52 clients made commitments to

Jesus Christ! In addition, Life Network staff and volunteers had 2,323 spiritual conversations with clients.

• 12 - 17 clients, mostly new Believers, participate in our Thursday night Bible study each month.

Ministry Statistics

 Help prepare, equip and empower clients to become healthy moms and dads to their

little ones through **241 mentoring visits** each month.

- 418 clients received STD testing, treatment and education through our medical outreach.
- 290 clients participated in 56 classes covering topics related to childbirth, infant care, relationships, finances and parenting.
- Present the importance of character development, avoiding sexual activity until marriage and living a healthy lifestyle to 8,055 students in 35 schools in El Paso County and surrounding areas. Presented parent

talks to **578 parents from 10 churches** and organizations.

 Facilitate 5 groups for individuals who have experienced an abortion; memorials were held honoring the lives of 26 babies.

Prevention

Valuable people make valuable choices is the message "Education for a Lifetime" (EFL) has delivered since 1987. Trained volunteers, local physicians and Life Network staff present this hope-filled, biblically based message to nearly 6,000 high school students each year. Presenting primarily in public schools, we teach: decision making, risk avoidance, goal setting and character education.

Through a curriculum called 'Pursue', this high energy, interactive program covers: living a life by design, healthy relationships, developing wisdom through critical thinking, seeing value in yourself, showing courage to stand up for yourself and others, and committing to a strong foundation for your future. Students shared the following after hearing the presentation:

• "You helped me **realize my value** and that I **deserve to be loved** correctly. You absolutely **changed my life** and I am changed for the better."

"... I had no clue how serious the consequences of having sex were. I used to think that if you used a condom you would be fine. I used to think pregnancy was the worst thing that could come from sex. Now I definitely know I'm wrong. Now I am determined to not have sex until marriage. Thank you for taking the time to teach me."

"I really appreciate you taking the time to come to my class, without this program to help guide me through life, I may have made a mistake that effects my whole future. I learned that I have the power and control to make my own decisions and know what is both ethically and morally good for me. I am going to remain un-sexually active until I'm married so I can set myself up for success. THANK YOU!"

In addition to Pursue, we offer parent talks through churches and community organizations to prepare and educate parents. Ultimately, we want teens to realize that making healthy choices will enable them to stay in school, attain a quality education and have the ability to focus on their life goals and dreams.



Intervention

The Colorado Springs Pregnancy Center and LifeSteps provide life-affirming support from the moment of a positive pregnancy test until a client's child is two. All services at the pregnancy center are free of charge including, options counsel, pregnancy tests, ultrasounds and STD testing.

LifeSteps offers parenting education, mentoring and practical support – such as baby items, clothing, diapers and food. Both programs are supported by faithful volunteers and Life Network staff. All of the baby supplies are donated by generous ministry supporters.

At 18, Michelle's* life spiraled out of control. Though raised in a Christian home, she chose friends in high school who led her down a path towards drugs, partying and dropping out of school. Her parents asked her to leave — and Michelle found herself working fast food and homeless. Michelle came to the pregnancy center for a pregnancy test with plans to schedule an abortion if her test was positive. At the pregnancy center, instead of feeling overwhelmed by her pregnancy news, she remembers feeling overwhelmed by the love and care of the volunteers and staff who met with her. She shares: "For the first time, in a long time, I felt that people actually cared about me. It made me feel not so alone, and like I could make a hard decision - like keeping my baby." Michelle had an ultrasound and the image of her baby made her choose life and cancel her abortion. The pregnancy

center helped her find medical care and connected her with LifeSteps where she took classes, completed lessons and

earned everything she needed for her baby.

With the help of her LifeSteps coach, Michelle sought a fresh start, walking away from her past and rediscovering the Jesus she knew as a little girl. Family relationships were restored and she moved back home. Today, Michelle thinks back on those days of despair, sharing: "Life Network helped me choose life. When I gave birth to my son ... that gave my life a purpose. Today I just want to help encourage girls in tough situations who feel like there is no hope and no way out, because I know there is a way."

Intervention

Men play crucial roles in the face of an unexpected pregnancy. The impact of fatherlessness is far-reaching as children without dads are more likely to be poor, become involved in drug and alcohol abuse, drop out of school, commit crimes and repeat the cycle of fatherlessness. From the early days of pregnancy, Life Network offers resources and support for men regarding how to be God-honoring fathers while also learning to support their partner. Over 75 men participate in the fatherhood outreach, meeting monthly with their

mentor coaches.

Their positive pregnancy test meant everything would change - plans for college, plans to travel and the perceptions of those who had known them forever. Jeremy* struggled with the choices they had made. He had known his girlfriend since childhood; their friendship developed into a relationship in high school – but both planned to go onto separate colleges and pursue the plans the Lord had for them. Though they were pro-life, she wrestled with abortion, knowing it could all be over and nobody would know. He reminded her of what they believed about life and their baby growing within.

The counsel and support they received at Life Network affirmed their decision to choose life as they were reminded that though their circumstances were a crisis, their baby was a gift. Jeremy began attending the Life Network fatherhood program. His coach encouraged him, prepared him and listened. They had long talks about what it means to support his partner, the skills needed to be a great father, and his coach encouraged him to never give up on his dreams to be in ministry.

They got married - and a few months later they celebrated the birth of their baby boy. Jeremy is pursuing Bible college and working to support his young family. He shares: "The fatherhood program was what I needed during a stressful time. My coach made me feel accepted and not judged ... it was tailored to what I wanted to learn and was a great time of fellowship and growth."

Transformation

While abortion in our country is declining, at least 1 in 4 women will have an abortion by the age of 45. Bridges of Hope offers a nine week group that addresses issues related to abortion and the opportunity to experience God's love and healing from the past ... helping individuals find forgiveness and honoring the lives of the children they have lost.

For 33 years, she carried the shame and regret of her abortion. "My life was changed by one email!" Jennifer* shared. She was a young Christian and successful in her career. However, she was married to an abusive man. When she discovered she was pregnant, she was terrified to bring a baby into her abusive situation. She felt abortion was the only choice. Her physician

referred her to a clinic, and she still clearly remembers that November day... wishing there was a different way but knowing there were no other options. She left the clinic empty and filled with the regret of one of the biggest mistakes of her life. She knew immediately she needed help — but there was no help to be found. She sought counsel from pastors and talked with others — but nothing offered relief.

As the years passed, Jennifer divorced and remarried. She had two more children — but never forgot her first. Decades later, Jennifer read an email from Family Talk about a woman who chose life instead of abortion in the midst of difficult circumstances. She followed up with this email and, with their help, was ultimately directed to Bridges of Hope.

Bridges of Hope was life-changing for Jennifer. For the first time ever, she felt free. She shares: "My whole world changed. My heart is not heavy. It's not hard to see babies anymore. I was so broken and now I am healed. I cannot believe how God is using my story." Jennifer is now in the process of being trained as a facilitator and looks forward to helping others find the same hope and healing.

Monday: Pray for our Board of Directors, staff and volunteers – that through them each client will see a glimpse of God's love. Pray none would grow weary as they serve each day.


